- 5. On page 5, line 10, strike "October 1, 2024" and insert in lieu thereof "April 1, 2025".

- 7. On page 5, line 17, strike "December 1, 2024" and insert in lieu thereof "April 1, 2025".
- 8. On page 5, line 18, strike the period and insert: "; and
- (7) by December 1, 2025 and by December 1 of each subsequent calendar year and in consultation with the health care authority department and any other appropriate state agency, provide a report to the legislative education study committee assessing the impact and outcomes of the pilot program and providing department recommendations.".
- 9. On page 5, strike lines 19 through 25 and on page 6, strike lines 1 through 3.
