15	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONTwenty million dollars
16	(\$20,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the

18	2025 to increase medicaid reimbursement for health care
19	services. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at
20	the end of fiscal year 2025 shall revert to the general fund.
21	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONTen million dollars
22	(\$10,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
23	health professional loan repayment fund for expenditure in
24	fiscal year 2025 to increase participation in the health
25	professional loan repayment program. Any unexpended or

 shall revert to the general fund.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION.--Two million dollars (\$2,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the children, youth and families department for expenditure in fiscal year 2025 to increase funding for educational stipend programs that receive matching federal funds pursuant to Title IV-E of the federal Social Security Act. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2025 shall revert to the general fund.

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS.--

A. The following amounts are appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in fiscal year 2025 for the following purposes:

(1) five million dollars (\$5,000,000) to support new physician resident slots at university of New Mexico health sciences center facilities;

(2) three million dollars (\$3,000,000) to compensate preceptors that supervise and train students seeking to become health care professionals; and

(3) ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) to pay faculty at the university of New Mexico college of population health.
