15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	SECTION 1. A new section of the Gross Receipts and
17	Compensating Tax Act is enacted to read:

19	TO RECOVER COMPENSATION FROM THE FEDERAL HERMIT'S PEAK/CALF
20	CANYON FIRE ASSISTANCE ACT
21	A. Gross receipts from the sale of legal services
22	rendered to and at the request of a person eligible to receive
23	compensation pursuant to the federal Hermit's Peak/Calf Canyon

2 Β. As used in this section, "legal services" means 3 services performed by a licensed attorney or under the 4 supervision of a licensed attorney for a client, regardless of 5 the attorney's form of business entity or whether the services 6 are prepaid, including legal representation before courts or 7 administrative agencies; drafting legal documents, such as 8 contracts or patent applications; legal research; advising and 9 counseling; arbitration; mediation; and notary public and other 10 ancillary legal services performed for a client in conjunction 11 with and under the supervision of a licensed attorney. "Legal 12 services" does not include lobbying or government relations 13 services, title insurance agent services, licensing or selling 14 legal software or legal document templates, insurance 15 investigation services or any legal representation involving 16 financial crimes or tax evasion in New Mexico."

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2024.
