17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	SECTION 1. Section 19-1-17 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1917,
19	Chapter 115, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
20	"19-1-17. PERMANENT, INCOME AND CURRENT FUNDSCREATING
21	DEPOSITS
22	A. The following funds <u>listed in Subsection B of this</u>
23	section are created.
24	B. To the credit of these funds, in the respective
