18	(1) the court of appeals shall receive an	
19	annual salary that is ninety-five percent of the annual

21	(2) a district court shall receive an annual

23	the chief judge of the court of appeals; and	
24	(3) a metropolitan court shall receive an

2	C. Notwithstanding any other provision of law or	
3	any other provision of this section, the annual salaries of	
4	the following judges shall be established as follows:	
5	(1) a judge of the court of appeals shall	
6	receive an annual salary that is ninety-five percent of the	
7	annual salary of a justice of the supreme court;	
8	(2) a district court judge shall receive an	
9	annual salary that is ninety-five percent of the annual	
10	salary of a judge of the court of appeals; and	
11	(3) a metropolitan court judge shall receive	
12	an annual salary that is ninety-five percent of the annual	
13	salary of a district court judge.	
14	D. The annual salary for magistrates shall be	
15	provided by the legislature in an appropriations act.	
16	E. No additional salaries shall be paid to	
17	justices, judges or magistrates on account of services	
18	rendered the state. Justices of the supreme court, judges of	
19	the court of appeals, district court judges, metropolitan	
20	court judges and magistrates shall receive per diem and	
21	mileage for necessary travel on official business of the court	
22	as provided in the Per Diem and Mileage Act."
