12	CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO TO PROVIDE THAT THE SALARIES OF
13	COUNTY OFFICERS SHALL BE ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
14	COMMISSIONERS, REMOVE REFERENCES TO THE FIRST LEGISLATIVE

18	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
19	SECTION 1. It is proposed to amend Article 10, Section 1
20	of the constitution of New Mexico to read:
21	"The legislature shall [ <del>at its first session</del> ] classify the
22	counties [and fix salaries for all county officers, which shall
23	also apply to those elected at the first election under this
24	constitution. And] of the state. No county officer shall
25	receive [ <del>to his own use</del> ] any fees or emoluments other than

6	shall be submitted to the people for their approval or
7	rejection at the next general election or at any special
8	election prior to that date that may be called for that
9	purpose.
