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18	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
19	SECTION 1. It is proposed to amend Article 4, Section 5
20	of the constitution of New Mexico to read:
21	"A. Each regular session of the legislature shall
22	begin annually at 12:00 noon on the third Tuesday of January.
23	Every regular session of the legislature [ <del>convening during an</del>
24	odd-numbered year] shall remain in session not to exceed sixty
25	days [and every regular session of the legislature convening

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1 during an even-numbered year shall remain in session not to 2 exceed thirty days]. No special session of the legislature 3 shall exceed thirty days. 4 Every regular session of the legislature B. 5 convening during an even-numbered year [shall consider only the 6 following: 7 (1) budgets, appropriations and revenue bills; 8 (2) bills drawn pursuant to special messages 9 of the governor; and 10 (3)] may consider for veto override bills of 11 [the last] a previous regular, [session vetoed by the governor] 12 special or extraordinary session within the same legislative 13 biennium." 14 SECTION 2.
