## HOUSE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 25

The Honorable Javier Martínez, Speaker of the House and Members of the House of Representatives State Capitol Building Santa Fe, New Mexico 87501

Honorable Speaker Martínez and Members of the House:

I have decided to veto HOUSE BILL 269, as amended, without emergency clause ("HB 269"), which would require the Health Care Authority ("HCA") to implement an open (aggregator) electronic visit verification system. This bill is unnecessary because the HCA is already working with vendors to implement an aggregator, with a current estimated completion date of October 2025.

Because of these issues, and pursuant to my authority under Article IV, Section 22 of the New Mexico Constitution, I have vetoed HOUSE BILL 269, as amended, without emergency clause, enacted by the Fifty-Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2025.
