15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	SECTION 1. Section 17-2-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967,
17	Chapter 8, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
