25	E. All central purchasing offices shall maintain,
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1	for a minimum of three years, records of sole source and
2	emergency procurements. The record of each such procurement
3	shall be public record and shall contain:
4	(1) the contractor's name and address;
5	(2) the amount and term of the contract;
6	(3) a listing of the services, construction or
7	items of tangible personal property procured under the
8	contract;
9	(4) whether the contract was a sole source or
10	emergency procurement contract; and
11	(5) the justification for the procurement
12	method."
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
