"PARENTAL GUIDANCE FOR WATER SAFETY .--

A. Each local school board and governing body of a charter school shall develop or adopt digital or written guidance for parents that promotes student safety in, on and around bodies of water and water infrastructure, including information about local options for age-appropriate swimming lessons and other water safety courses.

Β. Beginning in the 2025-2026 school year, all 18 public schools shall provide the parents of each student with 19 the guidance developed pursuant to Subsection A of this 20 section upon the student's enrollment at a public school or no 21 later than the tenth school day of a school year. The 22 guidance may be conspicuously incorporated into a district-23 wide or school-specific handbook published for parents and 24 students; provided that the public school receives written 25 HB 532
