Synopsis:

Enters New Mexico in the Psychology Interjurisdictional Compact, which standardizes the process for licensed psychologists to provide telepsychology services and temporary in-person psychological care across member states without requiring separate licenses in each jurisdiction; meant to bolster public health and safety across state lines and streamline cooperation between states when it comes to psychology licensure and regulation. This was introduced previously in 2025 HB242 and SB106.
