### **SECTION III: NARRATIVE**

#### **BILL SUMMARY**

##### Synopsis:

HB58 proposes to amend the existing crime of use of a telephone to terrify, intimidate, threaten, harass, annoy or offend to replace “telephone” with “electronic communication” throughout the statute. Section E adds definitions for “electronic communication” and “social media” as those terms are used in the proposed bill.

#### **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

The first part of HB58 duplicates most of HB 287 substituting “electronic services” for “telephone” sponsored in the 2025 general session by Representatives Reeb and Block. The second part of HB58 adds the definitions noted above that were not in HB287 last year. As in the AOC’s report on HB287, AOC does not believe that the bill has a fiscal or an administrative impact on the courts. The AOC cannot express an opinion about the content of a bill that does not have an impact on the courts and that at some point in the future could become subject to judicial review. Therefore, an analysis is not submitted. If the bill should change during its passage through the legislature and an impact on the courts be noted, the AOC will reply at that time.
