BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

Related to 2025 HB374, HB378, SB449, and others. This amends the Medical Malpractice Act to establish limitations on the claims for and the amount of punitive damages in a malpractice case. Extends the time frame for use of the Patient's Compensation Fund to cover judgments against a hospital or hospital-controlled outpatient health care facility. Redefines "occurrence" in the context of a malpractice claim.
