BILL SUMMARY

HB 181 appropriates \$100,000 from the general fund to the Children, Youth and Families Department (CYFD) for purposes of reporting children in state custody (CISC) subject to overnight office stays. The appropriation is made in FY 2027 for expenditures in FY 2027 and FY 2028, with any balance unspent at the end of FY 2028 reverting to the general fund.
