SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: This bill appropriates \$1,000.0 from the state general fund to the Workforce Solutions Department for expenditure in FY2027 to support lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and queer persons experiencing homelessness with eviction prevention and housing assistance

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

This bill appropriates \$1,000.0 from the state general fund to the Workforce Solutions Department for expenditure in FY2027, with any remaining amount reverting.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer persons (LGBTQ+) young adults, especially those with minimal natural supports, or with families who do not affirm their identities, are at greater risk for housing insecurity than other young adults. Family rejection or conflict over a young adult's sexual orientation or gender identity often results in the loss of basic supports that most young adults take for granted during the transition into adulthood.

Government support with eviction prevention and housing assistance can make a critical difference in a young adult's life, particularly when they may be facing a loss of natural supports simply for expressing who and what they naturally are.

LGBTQ+ children and youth are at increased risk for involvement with child welfare and juvenile justice system involvement because of this increased fragility of natural supports. CYFD's Fostering Connections program works with youth in foster care who are transitioning into adulthood, and housing stability is an element of that program. The expansion of eviction prevention and housing assistance programs for LGBTQ+ young adults generally, and those participating in Fostering Connections specifically, will improve long-term outcomes for this vulnerable population.

CYFD has performance measures concerning the successful participation in and completion of the Fostering Connections program which will benefit from this bill.

ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

Any administrative implications due to an expansion of available services to refer young adults to will be absorbed by existing resources.
