**BILL SUMMARY**

Synopsis: SB 0054 reduces how often certain mandatory trainings and professional development programs must be completed by public school personnel in New Mexico. It shifts several requirements from recurring trainings to primarily one-time completion within the first year of employment, while keeping core training obligation in place.

SB00054 does not impact the New Mexico Medicaid School Based Services program because it only modifies the timing and frequency of certain training requirements for public school personnel and does not change any Medicaid eligibility rules, covered services, provider qualifications, billing practices, or reimbursement policies related to school-based services. The bill focuses solely on education personnel training mandates and has no provisions affecting Medicaid-funded service delivery or administration.
