BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: Senate Bill 79 (SB79) appropriates \$2 million to the Department of Health for the purpose of mosquito surveillance, prevention, and mitigation. Additionally, SB79 authorizes the Department of Health to distribute funds up to \$1.5 million of the \$2 million appropriation in the form of grants to local governments, and state educational institutions for mosquito surveillance, prevention and mitigation projects.

This appropriation is nonrecurring, originates from the general fund, and is intended for expenditure in FY 27 and FY 28. Any unexpended balances at the end of FY 28 shall revert to the general fund.
