### **SECTION III: NARRATIVE**

#### **BILL SUMMARY**

Synopsis: Senate Bill 94 mandates that individuals convicted of various domestic violence offense must participate in and complete a domestic violence offender treatment or intervention program that is run by Children, Youth and Families Department (CYFD). The Bill also has provision if a domestic violence offender violation probation they will not receive credit for time already served on probation if a violation occurs.

#### **FISCAL IMPLICATIONS**

There is no funding mechanism for the program that CYFD is to create. There would be an increase in domestic violent offenders be on probation for a longer period thus increasing resource on the Department of Correction probation and parole.

#### **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

Senate Bill 94 would make the remaining domestic violence offenses consistent with domestic violence battery sentencing.

The current state of CYFD would be unable to implement such a program especially without proper funding. Probation and Parole would make more sense to implement the domestic violence program since they are already supervising the offender. Probation and Parole would also need additional funding to implement a domestic program.

The bill would be an unfunded mandate.
