## **SECTION III: NARRATIVE**

### **BILL SUMMARY**

Synopsis: This bill amends existing statute concerning domestic violence to require an individual convicted of crimes against a household member (assault, aggravated assault, assault with intent to commit a violent felony, three offenses of battery or aggravated battery, criminal damage to or deprivation of property), or convicted under the Family Violence Protection Act, be required to participate in, and complete, a domestic violence offender treatment or intervention (DVOTI) program approved by CYFD pursuant to regulation promulgated by CYFD.

CYFD is required to promulgate regulation by or before July 1, 2026, if no such regulation exists already.

### **FISCAL IMPLICATIONS**

There is no appropriation contained within this bill. These services have historically been paid for from the Domestic Violence Offender Treatment and Intervention Fund. With the passage of HB139 in 2023, the fees which funded this Fund have ceased. Expanding the population served by the DVOTI providers in New Mexico will require additional funds, and one (1) FTE program specialist @ \$90.0, which CYFD cannot absorb with existing resources.

### **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

This bill will result in an increase in the number of individuals required to complete participate in, and complete, a domestic violence offender treatment or intervention (DVOTI) program approved by CYFD.

For FY2025, a total number of 1800 individuals participated in DVOTI sessions.

### **PERFORMANCE IMPLICATIONS**

CYFD has performance measures concerning the safety of children which may be positively affected by an increase in treatment and intervention.

### **ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS**

CYFD will absorb any administrative implications stemming from updating existing regulation (8.8.7 NMAC) through existing resources. CYFD cannot absorb any administrative implications related to the expansion of the service population through existing resources.
