**BILL SUMMARY**

Synopsis: Senate Bill 111 adds language to the existing statutory definition of “personal information” in the Motor Vehicle Code, NMSA 1978, Section 66-1-4.14.

Section 1. Senate Bill 111 amends the definition of “personal information” in Section 66-1-4.14(F) to add “sex, gender identity, immigration status or national origin.”

For context, NMSA 1978, Section 66-2-7.1(A) (2025) prohibits current or former New Mexico Motor Vehicle Department (MVD) employees or MVD contractors from disclosing “personal information” obtained “by the department or bureau in connection with a driver’s license or permit, the titling or registration of a vehicle, the administration of the Ignition Interlock Licensing Act ... or an identification card issued by the department” to anyone outside of MVD except in limited scenarios listed in Section 66-2-7.1(A)(1)-(11), (B), (C).
