### **SECTION III: NARRATIVE**

#### **BILL SUMMARY**

SB-147 amends the Juvenile Community Corrections Act to expand and clarify allowable uses of the Juvenile Community Corrections Grant Fund by authorizing the Children, Youth and Families Department to both award grants and directly operate juvenile community corrections programs when necessary. The bill broadens eligible service populations to include adjudicated delinquents and referred children and youth up to age twenty-two, increases allowable administrative and monitoring costs from ten percent to twelve percent for both the department and grantees, and repeals outdated statutory provisions related to juvenile community corrections selection panels. Conforming amendments are made to the Tort Claims Act and the Governmental Immunity Act to align definitions with these changes. Overall, the bill increases programmatic and administrative flexibility without creating a new fund or appropriation.
