SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: This bill makes the following appropriations from the state general fund for expenditure in FY2027:

- \$1,000.0 to the Department of Public Safety to modernize and enhance the statewide operations and systems for turquoise alerts, AMBER alerts, Brittany alerts and silver alerts, as well as endangered and missing persons advisories;
- \$300.0 to the Department of Public Safety for two (2) FTE, one for the missing persons information clearinghouse to serve as a tribal liaison analyst and point of contact for tribal, state and local law enforcement, one for the information technology division to work as a developer on the development of a dedicated endangered persons and missing persons portal; and
- \$250.0 to the Indian Affairs Department to for a statewide outreach and public service campaign to build community awareness and understanding, improve response efficacy and strengthen trust in the turquoise alert system.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

This bill appropriates \$1,300.0 to the Department of Public Safety and \$250.0 to the Indian Affairs Department for expenditure in FY2027 with any remaining amount reverting.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The missing and endangered persons alert and advisory systems are a critical component of the public safety systems, and as with all public safety systems, maintenance and improvement are necessary to ensure they function.

CYFD has performance measures concerning the safety of children which may be affected by this bill.
