Synopsis: Senate Bill 245 propose to create a new crime of indecent exposure to a child out of public view. The elements are person must be eighteen years of age or older. The individual knowingly and intentionally exposes their primary genital area to a child. The exposure must be done in a lewd and lascivious manner. The incident must occur in a nonpublic place. a person found guilty of indecent exposure to a child out of public view would be charged with a fourth-degree felony.
