MULTICULTURAL EDUCATION ACT; REQUIRING ELIGIBLE PROGRAMS TO USE  
A HOME OR HERITAGE LANGUAGE AS THE PRIMARY MEDIUM OF  
INSTRUCTION OR TO USE A LANGUAGE REVITALIZATION INSTRUCTION  
MODEL APPROVED BY THE PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT; MAKING  
CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 22-23-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1973,  
Chapter 285, Section 6, as amended) is amended to read:

"22-23-6. BILINGUAL MULTICULTURAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS--  
ELIGIBILITY FOR STATE FINANCIAL SUPPORT.--[A.] To be eligible  
for state financial support, [each] a bilingual multicultural  
education program shall be approved by the department and  
shall:
