A MEMORIAL

PROCLAIMING FEBRUARY 6, 2026 AS "NEW MEXICO SPEECH-LANGUAGE AND
HEARING ASSOCIATION DAY" IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

hearing, speech or language impairment disorder that, if
untreated, can present significant obstacles to academic
achievement, social adjustment and career advancement; and

WHEREAS, audiology and speech-language pathology services
help empower individuals with communication disorders to lead
independent, productive and fulfilling lives; and

WHEREAS, audiologists and speech-language pathologists
work to eliminate or minimize the isolating effects of
communication disorders on affected families; and

WHEREAS, audiologists and speech-language pathologists
offer quality education and health care services to the people

2 WHEREAS, the New Mexico speech-language and hearing
3 association is a statewide professional body of speech-language
4 pathologists and audiologists with a mission to provide the
5 highest quality of support services;

7 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that Friday,
8 February 6, 2026, be declared "New Mexico Speech-Language and
9 Hearing Association Day" in the house of representatives and
10 that recognition be extended to the professional audiologists
11 and speech-language pathologists in the state for their
12 valuable service; and

14 transmitted to the New Mexico speech-language and hearing
