AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO COMPENSATE PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS FOR
ACHIEVING NATIONAL BOARD CERTIFICATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of compensating teachers who successfully complete the examination for national board certification. After receiving official notice from the national board for professional teaching standards verifying the national certification of a teacher, the department shall compensate the teacher in the amount of four percent of the teacher's salary. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
