MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR STATE MATCHING FUNDS NECESSARY TO OBTAIN FEDERAL FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR MANUFACTURING EXTENSION PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--One million one hundred thousand dollars (\$1,100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the economic development department for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 to be used as state matching funds to obtain federal funds available for manufacturing extension programs. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
