1 developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. 2 The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 3 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 4 5 The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are amended. 6 appropriated to the state highway and transportation department for the purpose of planning or designing, completing preliminary 7 work and completing a drainage report to widen route 66 in 8 9 McKinley county to four lanes. Any unexpended or unencumbered 10 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to 11 the severance tax bonding fund. If the state highway and 12 transportation department has not certified the need for the 13 issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the 14 authorization provided in this section shall be void. 15

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
