16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding three hundred
21	thousand dollars (\$300,000) when the board of regents of New
22	Mexico highlands university certifies the need for the issuance
23	of the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the
24	issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and
25	economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the

1 project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable 2 The state board of finance shall further take the 3 time. appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue 4 Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the 5 6 bonds are appropriated to the board of regents of New Mexico highlands university for the purpose of purchasing the Mora 7 school building to be used by New Mexico highlands university 8 9 located in San Miguel county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to 10 11 the severance tax bonding fund. If the board of regents of New 12 Mexico highlands university has not certified the need for the 13 issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the 14 authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
