AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO FUND A COMPUTER INTERACTIVE
TELEVISION PROGRAM FOR TEENAGE STUDENTS TO ADDRESS TEENAGE
ISSUES IN THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE LOCATED IN BERNALILLO COUNTY;
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --Two hundred thousand dollars
(\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state
department of public education for expenditure in fiscal years
1996 and 1997 for the purpose of funding a computer interactive
television program for teenage students that addresses teenage
issues in the city of Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county.
Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
