AN ACT
MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES
DEPARTMENT TO DEVELOP A PROGRAM TO DIVERT AT-RISK YOUTH FROM THE
CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM AND TO PROVIDE SCHOOL TEACHERS WITH
TECHNIQUES TO CORRECT NEGATIVE BEHAVIOR OF STUDENTS IN BERNALILLO
COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Three hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$315,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the children, youth and families department for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for the purpose of establishing or contracting with a nonprofit organization to establish a program designed to work with at-risk youth focused on building self-esteem and setting and achieving goals to divert them from the criminal justice system and to provide public school teachers with techniques to work with at-risk youth and to correct negative behavior in their students. This program may also be used as a sentencing option for juvenile court judges in Bernalillo county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
