AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY ACQUISITION AND
ARCHAEOLOGICAL STUDY AND MITIGATION FOR BLUEBERRY HILL ROAD IN
TAOS COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --One million two hundred fifty
thousand dollars (\$1,250,000) is appropriated from the general
fund to the state highway and transportation department for
expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for the purpose of
right-of-way acquisition and archaeological study and
mitigation. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at
the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. --It is necessary for the public
peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
