17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding twenty-eight thousand
21	dollars (\$28,000) when the New Mexico office of Indian affairs
22	certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state
23	board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the
24	bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible
25	upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed

1 sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 2 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 3 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the New 5 6 Mexico office of Indian affairs for the purpose of purchasing a tractor with machinery implements for farming irrigation 7 projects for the Naschitti community chapter in Sheep Springs 8 9 located in San Juan county. Any unexpended or unencumbered 10 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to 11 the severance tax bonding fund. If the New Mexico office of 12 Indian affairs has not certified the need for the issuance of 13 the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the authorization 14 provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
