RELATING TO JUVENILE SERVICES; AUTHORIZING DETENTION OF A JUVENILE IN A MULTIPURPOSE REGIONAL FACILITY PURSUANT TO A COURT ORDER ISSUED BY AN INDIAN TRIBE OR PUEBLO; ENACTING A NEW SECTION OF THE REGIONAL JUVENILE SERVICES ACT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

A new section of the Regional Juvenile Services Section 1. Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] DETENTION OF A JUVENILE IN A MULTIPURPOSE REGIONAL FACILITY PURSUANT TO A COURT ORDER ISSUED BY AN INDIAN TRIBE OR PUEBLO. --

The administrator of a multipurpose regional facility may receive a juvenile placed in detention in the facility pursuant to a court order issued by an Indian tribe or pueblo, in accordance with a joint powers agreement entered into by the administrator of the multipurpose regional facility and the Indian tribe or pueblo. The administrator shall keep the juvenile detained in the multipurpose regional facility until the juvenile is released pursuant to a court order issued by the Indian tribal court or the pueblo court.

- B. If a lawsuit is filed challenging the detention of a juvenile in a multipurpose regional facility pursuant to a court order issued by an Indian tribal court or a pueblo court, the administrator of the facility, the state of New Mexico and any municipality or county using the facility shall not be made a party to the lawsuit. The Indian tribe or pueblo that placed the juvenile in detention shall defend the lawsuit, and adjudication of the lawsuit shall take place in the Indian tribal court or the pueblo court.
- C. The provisions of this section shall not be interpreted as:
- (1) a waiver of sovereign immunity by any governmental entity;
- (2) consent by an Indian tribe or pueblo to the jurisdiction of a state court; or
- (3) consent by the state of New Mexico or any political subdivision thereof to the jurisdiction of an Indian tribal court or a pueblo court."
- Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 1996.
