AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR VARIOUS PROJECTS, PUBLIC PURCHASES AND PROGRAMS IN THE WEST MESA AREA IN BERNALILLO COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS -- AGENCY -- PURPOSE. --

A. Five hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$550,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 in the following amounts for the following purposes in the west mesa area of Albuquerque in Bernalillo county:

(1) one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for library books and library supplies for Valle Vista, Alamosa, Susie Rayos Marmon, Chaparral and Lavaland elementary schools, John Adams middle school and West Mesa high school;

(2) twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for
purchase and installation of additional security measures,
including grates and light poles, at the Alamosa elementary
school;

- (\$280,000) for purchase and installation of new computers, computer and technological accessories, software programs and computer supplies for use at Alamosa, Chaparral, Lavaland, Susie Rayos Marmon and Valle Vista elementary schools, John Adams middle school and West Mesa high school;
- (4) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to prepare and pave the parking lot at John Adams middle school; and
- (5) one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for a new fiber optic backbone system linking all computers located in various buildings on the campus of West Mesa high school.
- B. Three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 to contract for the design, development, expansion of and improvements to recreational facilities, including purchase of equipment and open space, at the Pat Hurley community center and park in the west mesa area of Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.
- C. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
