AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE
DISTRICT ATTORNEYS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING OR EXPANDING
DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAMS STATEWIDE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Three million three hundred forty-three thousand
twenty-six dollars (\$3,343,026) is appropriated from the general
fund to the administrative office of the district attorneys for
expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of establishing
or expanding domestic violence programs statewide.

B. To promote statewide consistency and coordination
of domestic violence services, the administrative office of the
district attorneys shall consult with New Mexico organizations
having expertise in domestic violence issues before approving

1 contracts for domestic violence counseling and support services.

2 C. The money shall be distributed by the
3 administrative office of the district attorneys as follows:

4 (1) two hundred eighty thousand dollars
5 (\$280,000) to the first judicial district attorney's office for
6 seven permanent full-time-equivalent positions and operating
7 expenses;

8 (2) eight hundred sixteen thousand two hundred
9 dollars (\$816,200) to the second judicial district attorney's
10 office for seventeen permanent full-time-equivalent positions
11 and operating expenses;

12 (3) one hundred sixty-three thousand dollars
13 (\$163,000) to the third judicial district attorney's office for
14 four permanent full-time-equivalent positions and operating
15 expenses;

16 (4) one hundred forty-eight thousand dollars
17 (\$148,000) to the fourth judicial district attorney's office for
18 four permanent full-time-equivalent positions and operating
19 expenses;

20 (5) two hundred seventy-eight thousand seven
21 hundred thirty dollars (\$278,730) to the fifth judicial district
22 attorney's office for seven permanent full-time-equivalent
23 positions and operating expenses;

24 (6) one hundred forty-seven thousand dollars
25 (\$147,000) to the sixth judicial district attorney's office for

19 contractual services;

20 (11) two hundred four thousand dollars
21 (\$204,000) to the twelfth judicial district attorney's office
22 for five permanent full-time-equivalent positions and operating
23 expenses; and

24 (12) two hundred eighty thousand dollars
25 (\$280,000) to the thirteenth judicial district attorney's office
