AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS; PROVIDING SCHOOL DISTRICTS WITH THE AUTHORITY TO ISSUE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS TO PURCHASE COMPUTER EQUIPMENT; INCLUDING THE PURCHASE OF COMPUTER EQUIPMENT WITHIN THE DEFINITION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS; AMENDING THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 22-18-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967, Chapter 16, Section 228) is amended to read:

"22-18-1. GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS--AUTHORITY TO ISSUE. -- Subject to the provisions of Article 9, Section 11 of the constitution of New Mexico and Sections [~~11-6-13 and 11-6-14 New Mexico Statutes Annotated, 1953 Compilation~~] 6-15-1 and 6-15-2 NMSA 1978, a school district may issue general obligation bonds for the purpose of erecting, remodeling, making additions to and

7 Section 2. Section 22-25-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1975
8 (S.S.), Chapter 5, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:

9 "22-25-2. DEFINITIONS. --As used in the Public School
10 Capital Improvements Act:

11 A. "program unit" means the product of the program
12 element multiplied by the applicable cost differential factor,
13 as defined in Section 22-8-2 NMSA 1978; and

14 B. "capital improvements" means expenditures,
15 exclusive of any debt service expenses, for:

16 (1) erecting, remodeling, making additions to,
17 providing equipment for or furnishing public school buildings;

18 (2) purchasing or improving public school
19 grounds;

20 (3) maintenance of public school buildings or
21 public school grounds, exclusive of salary expenses of school
22 district employees; [and]

23 (4) purchasing activity vehicles for
24 transporting students to extracurricular school activities; and

25 (5) purchasing computer software and hardware
