AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE
PUBLICATION OF VARIOUS NATIVE AMERICAN EVENTS AND ATTRACTIONS;
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION--ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT--PURPOSE.--Fifty
thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New Mexico office of
Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for the development, production
and distribution of a visitors' guide to publicize the customs, attractions, events and public
activity schedules of various Native American pueblos in northern New Mexico. Any
unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to
the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that
this act take effect immediately.
