AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICAL INVESTIGATIONS; PROHIBITING THE STATE MEDICAL INVESTIGATOR FROM CHARGING FOR CERTAIN SERVICES PERFORMED FOR AN INDIAN NATION, TRIBE OR PUEBLO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 24-11-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1971, Chapter 112, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:

"24-11-3. STATE MEDICAL INVESTIGATOR--QUALIFICATIONS--DUTIES--OFFICE. --

- A. The state medical investigator shall be a physician licensed to practice in New Mexico. Insofar as practicable, the medical investigator shall be trained in the fields of pathology and forensic medicine.
- B. The state medical investigator shall maintain his office at the [school of medicine at the] university of New

Mexico medical school.

- The state medical investigator shall appoint district medical investigators and, where necessary, deputy medical investigators who shall serve at his pleasure. state medical investigator may assign deputy medical investigators to districts to work under the supervision of a district medical investigator. The district medical investigator shall be a licensed physician. When deemed necessary by the state medical investigator, he may direct a deputy or district medical [examiner] investigator to enter another district for the purpose of carrying out medical i nvesti gati ons.
- Any district created by the state medical investigator to be staffed by a district medical investigator shall be coextensive with one or more counties.
- Ε. The state medical investigator may enter into agreements for services to be performed by persons in the course of medical investigations.
- F. The state medical investigator shall, subject to the approval of the board of medical [investigations] <u>investigators</u>, promulgate rules and regulations for the proper investigation of deaths occurring within this state.
- The state medical investigator shall maintain G. records of the deaths occurring within this state which are investigated by either state or district medical investigators.

section,	the state medical investigator shall also serve as the
di stri ct	medical investigator for Bernalillo county.

- I. Funds for the operation of the state and district medical investigators' offices shall be appropriated to and administered by the university of New Mexico medical school [$\frac{1}{100}$ medicine].
- J. The state medical investigator may not charge for services performed for an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo if the state medical investigator performs the same services for an agency or political subdivision of the state without charge."
