AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE INDIVIDUALIZED ACADEMIC AND JOB SKILLS TRAINING FOR AT-RISK YOUTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of contracting with a nonprofit corporation to work with the Taos, Gadsden, Las Vegas, Grants and Silver City school districts for services to provide an individualized alternative curriculum, including job skills training and work experience, to at-risk students in an effort to curb the dropout rate and prevent the need to further burden our social services system with individuals lacking workplace skills. The nonprofit corporation receiving the money shall submit a report indicating

progress and successes with the students. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
