12	SEVERANCE TAX BONDS FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS IN THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE
13	LOCATED IN BERNALILLO COUNTY; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN
14	EMERGENCY.
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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSAUTHORIZATIONS
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS
19	A. The state board of finance may issue and sell severance tax bonds in
20	compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the
21	amounts authorized for purposes specified in Sections 2 through 4 of this act. The state board
22 23	of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and
23 24	economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed
25	sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a
	reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to
	comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of the
	bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in Sections 2 through 4 of this act.
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1	B. The agencies named in Sections 2 through 4 of this act shall certify to the
2	state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds authorized
3	in this section is needed for the purposes specified in the applicable section of this act.
4	C. If the specified agency has not certified the need for the issuance of the
5	bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the authorization provided in this act shall be void.
6	D. Unless otherwise specified in this act, any unexpended or unencumbered
7	balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Sections 2
8	through 4 of this act at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax bonding
9 10	fund.
10 11	Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSDEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
11 12	ADMINISTRATIONPURPOSESPursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon
12	certification by the local government division of the department of finance and administration
14	that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the
15	local government division of the department of finance and administration for the following
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17	purposes:
18	A. five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to make improvements to meet
19	state child-care requirements and renovations throughout the Barelas community and child-care
20	center in the city of Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county;
21	B. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase equipment and furniture for
22	the Tom Bell community center addition in the city of Albuquerque located in Bernalillo
23	county;
24	C. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan, design and construct a weight
25	room and additional parking at the Dennis Chavez community center in the city of
	Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county; and
	D three hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan design and construct

D. three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design and construct

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phase III of the South San Jose community center in the city of Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county.

Section 3. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the state highway and transportation department that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) is appropriated to the state highway and transportation department for the purpose of making improvements to south Fourth street between Bridge and Coal streets in the city of Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county.

Section 4. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--STATE AGENCY ON AGING--PURPOSE.- Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the state agency on
aging that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, one hundred thousand dollars
(\$100,000) is appropriated to the state agency on aging for the purpose of completing the
expansion of the Barelas senior daycare center in the city of Albuquerque located in Bernalillo
county.

Section 5. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

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
