AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PETROLEUM RECOVERY RESEARCH CENTER AT NEW MEXICO INSTITUTE OF MINING AND TECHNOLOGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--One hundred eighty-five thousand dollars (\$185,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico institute of mining and technology for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of matching federal grants to operate the petroleum recovery research center for technology transfer and enhanced oil recovery. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
