### AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE OF CULTURAL AFFAIRS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PRESENTING EXHIBITIONS AND PUBLIC PROGRAMS REGARDING TIBETAN CULTURE AT THE MUSEUM OF INTERNATIONAL FOLK ART LOCATED IN SANTA FE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--One hundred eighty-five thousand dollars (\$185,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the office of cultural affairs for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of presenting exhibitions and public programs regarding Tibetan culture at the museum of international folk art located in Santa Fe. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall convert to the general fund.
