

11	RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF
12	SEVERANCE TAX BONDS TO DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT A SEWER PLANT
13	REPLACEMENT FOR THE VILLAGE OF JEMEZ SPRINGS IN SANDOVAL COUNTY;
14	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS The state board of finance may issue and sell severance
19	tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one
20	million one hundred thousand dollars (\$1,100,000) when the department of environment
21	certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the
22 23	issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a
23 24	finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and
25	that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance
	shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of
	1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the department
	of environment for the purpose of designing and constructing a sewer plant replacement for the

2	balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.
3	If the department of environment has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the
4	end of fiscal year 1998, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.
5	Section 2. EMERGENCYIt is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that
6	this act take effect immediately.
