AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; REAUTHORIZING UNEXPENDED OR UNENCUMBERED BALANCES; CHANGING AGENCIES AND CONTINGENCIES OF A CAPITAL PROGRAM FUND APPROPRIATION AND A SEVERANCE TAX BOND AUTHORIZATION; EXTENDING PERIODS OF EXPENDITURE; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. CAPITAL PROGRAM FUND-- CHANGE IN AGENCY-- CONTINUED AUTHORIZATION-- CHANGE IN CONTINGENCY-- APPROPRIATION. -- The capital program fund appropriation, pursuant to Paragraph (2) of Subsection U of Section 2 of Chapter 6 of Laws 1990 (1st S.S.), for the construction of a home for homeless children shall be appropriated to the local government division of the department of finance and administration to plan, design, construct and furnish a home for homeless children in

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1 Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county, provided that the city
2 of Albuquerque receives a donation from a private or public
3 organization of a minimum of ten acres of land for constructing
4 the home and that the city of Albuquerque, through its child
5 development office, executes a contract with the private or
6 public organization donating the land requiring that the
7 organization agree to operate the home for a minimum of ten
8 years. Notwithstanding the provisions of Laws 1995, Chapter
9 218, Section 27, any unexpended or unencumbered balance
10 remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the
11 capital program fund.

12 Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--CHANGE IN AGENCY--
13 CONTINUED AUTHORIZATION--CHANGE IN CONTINGENCY-- APPROPRIATION. --

14 The balance of the proceeds from severance tax bonds
15 appropriated to the general services department, pursuant to
16 Laws 1992, Chapter 113, Section 20, for the New Day shelter for
17 troubled youth in Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county shall
18 not be expended by that agency nor be subject to the contingency
19 imposed but is reauthorized and appropriated to the local
20 government division of the department of finance and
21 administration and shall be contingent upon the city of
22 Albuquerque receiving a donation from a private or public
23 organization of a minimum of ten acres of land for building the
24 home, and the city of Albuquerque, through its child development
25 office, executing a contract with the private or public

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1 organization donating the land requiring that the organization
2 agree to operate the home for a minimum of ten years.

3 Notwithstanding the provisions of Laws 1995, Chapter 218,
4 Section 27, any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at
5 the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax
6 bonding fund.

7 Section 3. EMERGENCY. --It is necessary for the public
8 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
