BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the tourism department for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for the purpose of providing educational, historical and cultural activities in celebration of the Santa Fe trail's one hundred seventy-fifth anniversary in five northern New Mexico counties. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
