## AN ACT <br> MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AT THE <br> ALBUQUERQUE MUSEUM IN BERNALILLO COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Fifty thousand dollars $(\$ 50,000)$ is appropriated from the general fund to the office of cultural affairs for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for the purpose of supporting various educational performance programs for youth at the Albuquerque museum in Bernalillo county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
