RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; REAUTHORIZING UNEXPENDED OR UNENCUMBERED BALANCES; EXPANDING THE PURPOSE OF A CERTAIN SEVERANCE TAX BOND AUTHORIZATION TO INCLUDE THE PECOS RIVER VILLAGE CONFERENCE CENTER LOCATED IN EDDY COUNTY; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION--EXPANSION OF PURPOSE--APPROPRIATION.--The balance of the proceeds from severance tax bonds appropriated to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for the Carlsbad civic center in Eddy county, pursuant to Subsection EEEE of Section 9 of Chapter 148 of Laws 1994, shall be expanded to include making improvements to and expanding and paving the parking lot at the Pecos River Village
