AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE NEW MEXICO OFFICE OF INDIAN AFFAIRS TO PLAN AND DESIGN A MULTIPURPOSE CENTER FOR YOUTH PROGRAMS AT THE PUEBLO OF NAMBE LOCATED IN SANTA FE COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred forty thousand dollars (\$140,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of planning and designing a multipurpose center for youth programs at the pueblo of Nambe located in Santa Fe county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
